1. The minutes of the last meeting of the IQAC were read out to the members and the same were confirmed.

2. Following points were taken up in detail:

Sr. No.	Agenda Point	Discussion
1	Strategic/ perspective plan for 2020-21 to 2024-25.	Chairman, IQAC, Dr Ajay Sharma shared with all the members, the Perspective Plan: 2020-2025. He emphasized that SACCM needs to make investments in faculty empowerment, research infrastructure and teaching-learning infrastructure (hostels, staff residences, virtual labs, incubation facilities etc.). He added that the college needs to make structural and strategic changes in light of the main doctrines of the upcoming new education policy. Discussion at length took place on various key points like introduction of new courses, collaborations with other stakeholders of higher education, Financial management & Resource Mobilization, research publication and awards etc.
2	Documentation Process	Development and maintenance of institutional database is very important for enhancing the institutional quality and is also pre-requisite under assessment & accreditation of any HEI. To this end, discussion at length took place and it was proposed that IQAC will devise various e-links for the smooth collection of data of various activities/ programmes/ events. Further, faculty

		concerned would update the data in these links on a regular basis and finally, IQAC will compile and finalize the data on 10th day of every month.
3	Teachers feedback on effectiveness of curricula, online classes and IT related issues	A good feedback system has an active role to play for the growth of any higher education institution as it does not only confine to the collection of data, rather it goes beyond that and extends to its in-depth analysis, identification and drawing pertinent pointers to enhance the learning effectiveness. To this end, it was suggested that a comprehensive feedback form would be shared with the members of the faculty to check their level of satisfaction towards the effectiveness of curriculum, teaching, learning, infrastructure and particularly about their online teaching experience.

2.	Development and maintenance of institutional database	The College's IQAC shared various e-links with all the members of the faculty to streamline the updating of institutional database.
3.	Teachers' Feedback Analysis session	As mentioned at the last IQAC meeting, a comprehensive feedback performa was shared with all faculty members.
