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The following issues were discussed:

1. The meeting was commenced with welcome address by Chairman - IQAC.
2. The minutes of the previous meeting held on 26th March, 2018 were read out and confirmed.
3. The revised guidelines for preparation & submission of AQAR were discussed & distributed to apprise the members about the changes and it was decided that a separate meeting shall be held with the criteria heads for detailed discussions on these guidelines.

4. From agenda items the following issues were taken up

A. Nurturing Culture in College

I. It was proposed that at the time of induction of new entrants, an Alumnus may be invited to speak about the vision & mission of the college and also share with them about his experience during his stay in the College..

II. It was resolved that in order to reduce the stress level amongst students, a lecture on meditation shall formely be a part of college time table for first year students(both B Com & BBA).

III. Further resolved that in order to suggest the measures to be adopted for inculcating cultural values amongst students and for building a sense of responsibility, belongingness & pride amongst faculty members, following committees be constituted.

E. Seminars

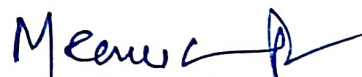
It was proposed that the RFDC shall explore, plan and organise seminars for students in which they can interact with CEO's of successful companies.
