Please Note:

1. The Merit List shall be displayed one day before the dates mentioned above for admission counselling of the respective classes.

2. For admission in First Semester and new admissions (against vacant seats) in Third and Fifth Semester classes, it is compulsory for the parents to accompany the candidate at the time of Admission Counselling.

3.Payment of Fees- Successful candidates shall have to deposit fee on the spot to confirm admission.

4. The dates mentioned above are tentative and may be changed as per University Calendar. All applicants are required to confirm the dates for counselling, fee payable and date of commencement of teaching from the College Office.

OVERSEAS STUDENTS

The College follows the guidelines issued by the Panjab University for the admission of overseas students.

COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

EXAMINATION & INTERNAL ASSESSMENT RULES

I. EXAMINATION RULES FOR B. COM (GENERAL) AND BBA CLASSES

A. ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING IN END SEMESTER EXAMINATION (ESE) (AS PER **UNIVERSITY GUIDELINES)**

In order to be eligible, a student:

(i)is required to be on the rolls of the College during the semester preceding the End Semester Examination.

(ii)is required to attend at least 75% of the lectures delivered (the teaching days to be counted up to a week before the commencement of exams).

(iii) has to score the minimum pass marks in Mid Semester Tests (MSTs) prescribed by University which is mentioned below:

(a)B. Com Course: 35% marks in each paper as well as in aggregates in MST.

(b) BBA Course: 40% marks in each paper and 50% marks in aggregates in MST.

(iv) has to obtain minimum pass marks in internal assessment as prescribed by University i.e 35% per subject in B.Com course and 40% per subject in BBA course.

IN CASE ANY STUDENT FAILS TO FULFIL ANY OF THE ABOVE STATED ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS, HE/SHE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO APPEAR IN END SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS (ESE).

B. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Semester System of education is based on continuous assessment of the learning assimilated by the student. As such, assessment for the period of one semester is based on the following components:

(a) Internal

i.Assignment -It is compulsory for each student to submit his/her assignment within the given time frame to the subject incharge.

ii.Mid Semester Test (MST) - Internal in nature and will be held after a period of about three months after the start of the semester.

iii. Attendance-A student is required to maintain at least 75% of attendance in each subject till the last teaching day of each semester.

(b) External

End Semester Examination (ESE) - External in nature and will be conducted by the University at the end of the period of six months.

C. RULES FOR SPECIAL TEST

The chance for special test will be given only to those students who were absent in MSTs with the prior permission from College authorities due to unavoidable circumstances. Unauthorised absentees and late coming students who were not allowed to take the MST, will not be allowed to appear in Special Test as well. Accordingly, they will be given zero credit in MST.

III.EXAMINATION RULES FOR B.COM HONS. IIIrd/ IVh/Vth/ Vith SEMESTER A.ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING IN B. COM HONS. UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

Attendance: All rules of College attendance policy shall apply to B.Com Hons. programme also.

Mid Semester Test (MST): A student will be required to appear in the Mid Semester Test (MST) in Honours and must score a minimum of 50% marks to be eligible for appearing in Panjab University End Semester Examinations.

THE STUDENTS WHO DO NOT MEET EITHER OF THE ABOVE TWO CRITERIA, THEIR NAME WILL BE STRUCK OFF FROM HONS. COURSE PERMANENTLY WITHOUT ANY CHANCE OF READMISSION.

B. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Semester System of education is based on continuous assessment of the learning assimilated by the student. As such, assessment for the period of one semester is based on two parameters.

(a) Internal

- Assignment -It is compulsory for each student to submit his/her assignment within the given time frame to the subject incharge.
- Mid Semester Test (MST) -Internal in nature and will be held after a period of about three months after the start of the semester.
- iii. Attendance -a student is required to maintain at least 75% of attendance in each subject till the last teaching day of each semester.

(b) External

End Semester Examination (ESE)- External in nature and will be conducted by the University at the end of the period of six months.

C. NO SPECIAL TEST: No special test will be conducted for the students who fail to meet the above mentioned criteria of Hons. MST.

EVEN IVTH/VTH/VITH SEMESTER HONS. STUDENT WHO HAS PASSED THE HIRD/VITH/VTH SEMESTER HONS. EXAMINATION RESPECTIVELY CONDUCTED BY UNIVERSITY WILL BE DISALLOWED TO CONTINUE WITH THE HONS. COURSE IF HE/ SHE FAILS TO FULFIL ANY OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED CONDITIONS.

IV.GUIDELINES FOR MID SEMESTER TESTS

- Unauthorized Absence: Absence in MST for any reason whatsoever would mean grant of zero award in that particular subject. The information regarding unauthorized absentee will be communicated to the parents of the student.
- Authorized Exemption(Unavoidable Circumstances) will cover only following two cases:
 - -Students sent by the College to attend Youth Festival, Sports Competitions or any other Inter College Events.
 - -Students who are permitted by the College (at Principal's discretion) to appear in any competitive exam during MSTs.

BARRING THE ABOVE STATED CASES, NO OTHER CASE FOR EXEMPTION IN ANY OF THE EXAMINATIONS WILL BE ENTERTAINED FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER



- · Medical Leave during Examination
- Grant of leave during exams is an exception and such leave may be sanctioned if supported with a 'Medical Certificate' issued by a Medical Specialist with a minimum qualification of MD.
- The parents of the students availing medical leave will have to personally submit the leave application immediately (preferably beforehand or latest by the day of examination) and in case of unavoidable circumstances not later than one day from the date of medical inability to attend the College. The leave during examinations has to be submitted to the Examination Incharge only after getting it sanctioned from the Principal. Leaves submitted later than the prescribed period will not be accepted.

LATE COMING NOT ALLOWED

STUDENTS MUST BE SEATED IN EXAMINATION VENUE TEN MINUTES BEFORE THE START OF EXAM. ONLY IN EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES, LATE COMING MAY BE ALLOWED FOR MAXIMUM FIFTEEN MINUTES AFTER THE START OF EXAM. ANY STUDENT WHO REACHES EXAMINATION ROOM BEYOND FIFTEEN MINUTES AFTER THE START OF EXAM (FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER) WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO TAKE THAT EXAM.

• Unfair Means Case- All those who are caught using unfair means* in the MSTs will be fined Rs.1000 and their paper will be cancelled with zero credit in that paper. And, if a student is caught using unfair means for the second time during his/ her total stay since joining the College, a fine of Rs.1500 will be charged. If the student is caught using unfair means for the third time during his/ her total stay since joining the College; he /she will be rusticated straight away and re-admission will not be allowed. Also, a student who is rusticated on grounds of using unfair means during examination, shall not be eligible for admission in the College in the subsequent semesters. Use of unfair means (even once) during Examinations will also automatically render a student ineligible for the award of any prize, concession, scholarship or stipend for that particular semester.

*Unfair Means Case: A student will be said to have used unfair means if any incriminating material is found in his/her possession during the MSTs.

ATTENDANCE RULES

Practice of attending regular classes makes a student responsible, disciplined and a good time manager. Regular class attendance is crucial for the education and overall development of students as it provides them with an Active Learning Experience. Explanations, clarifications, discussions, opportunities for feedback and group tasks etc. are invaluable components of an effective learning environment, the benefits of which can be availed only by attending classes regularly.

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The College expects that every student attends 100% of the lectures delivered in each subject during the session. In order to ensure regular attendance, the following attendance policy will be applicable:

REGULAR COMMUNICATION TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS IN CASE OF SHORTAGE IN ATTENDANCE

Attendance will be calculated for each subject separately on weekly basis. In case the attendance of any student is less than 75% at the end of a month, his/her parents will be informed immediately about the same. In addition to this, parents will be also informed about the attendance of their ward in all subjects on daily/weekly basis.

CONTINUOUS ABSENCE FOR CONSECUTIVE FOUR WORKING DAYS

Every student shall attend his/her classes on all working days unless he/she is granted leave by the College. If a student remains absent from his/her class for a continuous period of four working days without authorized leave, his/her name will be struck off from the College rolls and the parents of the student will be informed about the same immediately through an SMS. Re-admission may be given in accordance with the rules of re-admission.

LEAVES

Approved Leave is counted as 'Absence'. It is just an 'authorized absence' with zero attendance benefit, although no fine will be imposed for the authorized absence. The College will sanction leave only within the framework laid down by the University. Every student must have attended at least 75% of the total lectures delivered in every subject.

(Note: There will be approximately 90 lectures in odd and 70 lectures in even semesters. The students are therefore advised to judiciously plan their leaves.)

EXEMPTION FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

A maximum of four day and three day exemption will be allowed to the fifth and sixth semester students respectively for appearing in CAT and other Entrance examinations on the recommendation of the respective Class-Incharge subject to approval by the Principal.

EXEMPTION FOR CA/CS/ICWA EXAMINATION

A maximum of four day exemption for IPCC/Inter/Final exams will be allowed to students appearing in CA/CS/ICWA exams on the recommendation of the respective Class-Incharge subject to approval by the Principal.






Performance Management through Academic Action Plans




