Report for the session 2015-16

Independent thinking exercise is aimed at intellectually stimulating students to make independent opinion about various economic, political, social and ethical issues and trust their own judgment. The activity not only promotes independent thinking but also provides a platform for expression of the thoughts. For the current academic year, the first session of ITE was held with 50 students who were filtered in the subsequent sessions. The students were evaluated on the basis of Originality, Logic and Conviction with which they put forth their views. After being shortlisted in the preliminary round, students strived to clinch the title of **best Independent Thinkers** by passing through five successive levels of increasing difficulty with details as follows:
