



Sri Aurobindo College of Commerce and Management (SACCM) invited Dr. Ashish Virk, Associate Professor, University Institute of Law, Panjab University, Regional Centre, Ludhiana, to talk about the topic 'Legal Dimension of Gender Equity in Reference with Transgender as Third Gender: A Critical Analysis'.

Director Sushil Kumar and Principal Marinal Gupta received and introduced the guest. The Director appraised students about the seminal works of Leonard Sax (A Practising American Psychologist), like 'Boys Adrift', 'Girls on the Edge' and 'Why Gender Matters' to set the tone. The lecture started with the biological and psychological concept of transgender community. It was only later in 2019 that transgender were considered as third gender and also included inter-sex. The Speaker also discussed that it was in 2019 when finally an Act for protection of Transgender Rights in India has been passed. The social hardships faced by transgender were also discussed. The alarming picture of Indian schools and colleges for transgender children and youth is heart throbbing. It is their struggle for social acceptance which is ultimately leading to suicides. Speaker concluded her talk by highlighting that it's time that this huge legal gap should be walked into. Being Trans isn't choice, being transphobic is' was imbibed by students. Ultimately the speaker was diligently able to sensitize them about gender equity.




#### Report on celebration of Women's Day


### Health Issues and Healthy Life Style

### CYBER SECURITY AND DATA PROTECTION




An Interactive Session on 'I Am Enough'
